1. Applications are invited for filling up 01 Post of **PROGRAMMER** in A.P. Police Computer Services from the eligible '**IN-SERVICE**' candidates of the Police Department by Direct Recruitment. This is special Recruitment and is being done as a special case by invoking Rule-10(a) of Andhra Pradesh and Subordinate Service Rules, 1996.

2. The recruitment of the above Post is being made as per the G.O. Ms.No.99 Home (Ser.III) Department, dated 02-09-2020.

3. For this Post, the Rule of Reservation i.e for BC-A, BC,C, BC-D, BC-E, SC, ST and Ex-Servicemen provided in Rule 22 of A.P. State & Subordinate Service Rules, 1996, will **not be applicable** as the total sanctioned strength of Programmers is 2 only.

4. **SCALE OF PAY:** Rs.28940– 78910

5. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:

- A. For this post of Programmer both men and women are eligible.
- B. Only '**IN-SERVICE**' candidates of the Police Department (both Executive & Ministerial) are eligible.
- C. Minimum Service: Not less than **6 years** without any OE pending or currency of punishment (Minor/Major), as on 01-07-2020.

D. AGE LIMIT:

Maximum age limit is **42 years** (as notified by the APPSC for Group-1 Services Exams, 2020 for certain posts), as on 01-07-2020.

No relaxation of age limit is allowed as all candidates belong to "In-service" and since no Rule of Reservation is applicable.

E. QUALIFICATIONS:

Must possess:

A Master's Degree in any of subjects mentioned herein (Maths/Physics/Statistics/Computers) with one year experience in Computer Programming.

OR

A Bachelor's Degree in Computers, with one year experience in Computer Programming.

OR

A Bachelor's Degree in (Computer Science / Maths/ Physics/ Statistics) with one year experience in Computer Programming.

OR

A Bachelor's Degree in any faculty with a Diploma in Computer Applications (Commercial) with one year experience in Computer Programming

OR

B. Tech (Computer Science), with one year experience in Computer Programming.

OR

Master of Computer Applications (MCA), with one year experience in Computer Programming.

OR

Master of Science (M. SC) Computer Programming with one year experience in Computer Programming.

OR

PG Diploma in Computers, with one year experience in Computer Programming.

6. APPLICATION FORM:

Candidates must apply in the Application Form (Off-line) which can be downloaded from website www.slprb.ap.gov.in in the recruitment folder or obtained from the concerned Unit Office. The Applicants should go through the Notification circulated by the respective Unit Officers or from the above website. Applications obtained from any other source or xerox copies will not be accepted.

7. LAST DATE FOR RECEIPT OF APPLICATIONS:

(i) Eligible candidates should submit the duly FILLED-IN Application Form along with the copies of the necessary certificates to their concerned Unit Officer on or before 30-09-2020. The Unit Officers concerned should countersign in the specified place of Application and send it to the Police Headquarters, Mangalagiri, by Special Messenger to reach on or before 07-10-2020.

(ii) The Unit Officers concerned should not accept the Applications submitted after 17-00 hrs on 30-09-2020. The incomplete Application Form without prescribed enclosures should not be entertained.

8. SELECTION PROCEDURE:

The selection procedure will be as follows:

A. WRITTEN EXAMINATION (Objective type)

The eligible candidates will have to appear a written examination in the following subjects followed by Viva-Voice on the basis of which the Selection will be finalised.

9. SELECTION:

The Selection of the candidate will be in two stages – Written Examination and Interview (Viva-Voice). On the basis of marks scored by candidates in the Written Examination, top three candidates (in the ratio of 1:3) will be selected for the Interview. After the interview round is conducted, Candidate scoring the maximum marks aggregately (The marks obtained in written exam, Practical and in Viva-Voice combinedly) will be selected and appointed finally.

10. The selection of the candidate will be provisional and subject to verification of the Original Certificates, antecedents and medical examination.

11. Antecedents verification: No person shall be eligible for appointment to any service by direct recruitment unless he satisfies the selection authority as well as the appointing authority that his character and antecedents are such as to qualify him/her for such service.

12. Suppression of material facts or withholding any factual information in the attestation form (which would be supplied to the candidate who will be provisionally selected) will disqualify the candidate from being considered for appointment. In the event of any information being found false or incorrect or ineligibility

13. HALL TICKET/ ADMIT CARD

The Admit Card will be issued separately for the two stages (Written Exam and Interview rounds) containing important details like the name of the candidate, roll number, registration number, category, parent's name, exam date & time and the exam centre venue, scanned photograph and signature and the exam day guidelines. Candidates will have to carry their valid photo ID along with the Hall Ticket.

14. Applications received incomplete in any respect or those not accompanied by necessary documents will not be considered. Application not routed through Unit Officers will be rejected and such candidates will not be allowed to appear in Examination.

15. Experience Certificate (one year computer programming) must be submitted along with application form. It is clarified here that experience certificate issued by concerned Unit Officers will only be valid.

16. The Dist./Unit Authorities concerned should ascertain that the particulars furnished in the Application Forms by the candidates are correct, as per the Service Records and all the relevant certificates have been enclosed with application. Incomplete application and application received after the time limit prescribed will be summarily rejected.
